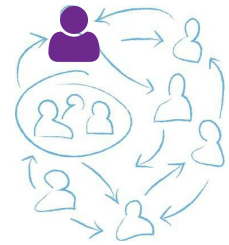


What are knowledge brokers and how can they help?

A knowledge broker is...

"An intermediary or linkage agent, using interpersonal contacts to stimulate knowledge exchange, the development of new research and the application of solutions"

- Ward et al. (2009)



A knowledge broker can...

Provide knowledge exchange expertise



- Develop plans for getting the right info to the right people at the right time
- Increase awareness about projects and their outcomes
- Create plain language material to communicate with specific audiences
- Monitor and evaluate knowledge exchange activities
